2.	Any further modification in the design and capacity of the equipment/ machinery than those proposed shall require fresh EC.	:	No any further modification in the design and capacity of the equipment / machinery shall be done without approval of fresh EC.
3.	Consent to Establish/ Consent to operate shall be obtained from Uttarakhand Environment Protection and Pollution Control Board under relevant provisions of Central Air Act and Central Water Act before starting up of any construction activity at the site.	:	Consent to Establish and Consent to Operate has been obtained from UEPPCB under relevant provisions under Section 21 of "Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act 1981" and under Section 25 of "Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act 1974". Residual Agricultural waste generated from processing of Spices & Herbs in the existing process of herbal extraction shall be used as fuel in the proposed boiler.	:	Agreed, Residual agricultural waste i.e. Biomass generated from processing of Spices & Herbs in the existing process of Herbal Extraction unit is being used as a fuel (briquette form) in the Biomass fired boiler.
6.	There shall not be enhancement in the capacity of production or capacity of any existing equipment's / machineries in the unit.	:	Agreed.
7.	Fire prevention and safety of workforce shall be as per the approval plan from authorized agency.
